- Quality Improvement participates in continuous quality improvement work
- Teamwork works collaboratively as a member of the interdisciplinary team
- Administrative contributes to the development, implementation and evaluation of clinical protocols and medical directives and other process improvements
- Mentoring supports and evaluates students, medical residents, and other learners

- RN (EC) license to practice from College of Nurses of Ontario
- Experienced as a Nurse Practitioner, with preference to those with experience in primary health care or in a community setting
- Experience working effectively with communities and individuals who face barriers accessing health care and other supports; with a focus on mental health challenges and problematic substance use preferred
- Demonstrated problem-solving, organizational, and interpersonal skills with an ability to work effectively and respectfully in a collaborative, interdisciplinary team environment
- Understanding of and experience utilizing a trauma-informed approach preferred
- Work hours include one evening shift per week and participation in a "on call" rotation
